Qualifications

In addition to a High School Diploma (preferably with a Specialty/Technical Training) and at least 2 years of experience in A/C, Heating, electrical, plumbing or other trade, the preferred candidate will have:

- Effective communication skills with co-workers and members
- A basic understanding of electrical, hydraulic, HVAC and other systems
- Proficient mechanical skills
- A working knowledge of tools, common appliances, and devices
- The ability to operate all equipment used for maintenance
- A valid driver's license

Working Conditions
